Position: Security Guard

Overview:

A security guard is responsible for protecting the assets and employees of the company. They must have completed a minimum of 120 hours of certified security training with a recognized security firm or law enforcement agency. They are responsible for controlling arguments, fights and other altercations by and between customers and employees on company property, identifying and apprehending shoplifters, preventing theft or willful destruction of company assets, escorting customers and employees to their vehicle and making a general presence in the store to deter actions detrimental to the business.

Job Requirements:

1. Have completed at least 120 hours of certified security training with a recognized security firm or law enforcement agency.
2. Have a working knowledge of local, state and federal laws and regulations as they pertain to theft, arrest, and related security issues.
3. Be currently covered by fidelity bond.
4. Follow verbal & written instructions.
5. Provide verbal & physical assistance to customers.
6. Operate telephones and intercoms.
7. Provide escort services to customers and employees on company property.
